To Whom This May Concern:

Members of the Sutter Buttes 4-H club have been approved to solicit donations on behalf of their club. Donations collected will be used at their upcoming fundraising dinner and auction being held on Tuesday, March 11, 2025. This annual event raises funds that are used to support club activities, community service projects, and provides scholarships to graduating seniors who have demonstrated great work and service in the Sutter Buttes 4-H club.

4-H is a national youth organization. The purpose of 4-H is to build capable, confident, and caring young individuals who are prepared to meet the challenges of a rapidly changing world. This is accomplished by engaging youth in hands-on learning experiences led by caring adults. In Sutter and Yuba Counties, there are 12 4-H clubs that reach nearly 600 youth members and 200 adult leaders.

4-H is a recognized 501(c)(3) organization. It is part of the Regents of the University of California ("The Regents") which is the legal entity composing the University of California system, it consists of ten campuses and the Office of the President. The University of California is the land grant university for the State of California created by the State Legislature in 1868 and was originally recognized by the IRS as exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) in 1939.

The Office of the President is the central administrative office of the UC system. Within this office is the Division of Agriculture and Natural Resources ("ANR") which operates the 4-H Youth Development Program, including over 800 4-H clubs throughout the State of California. The 4-H clubs' activities are tax-exempt under the umbrella of the university's section 501(c)(3) status. The University of California's FEIN number is 94-3067788.
